Facility and Accommodations

Our new home is 200 acre **Camp Ramblewood** in Darlington, MD. It is 45 minutes north of Baltimore and 2 1/2 hours south of New York. The grounds include an open-air dance pavilion, a large dance hall, wooded hills with hiking trails, a pond with sandy beach, a swimming pool, a diving pool, volleyball, tennis and basketball courts.

Housing is in male, female and couples cabins with windows and ceiling fans. Indoor hot water showers, sinks and toilets are either in or attached to all cabins. Dancers must bring towels, linens, pillows and blankets. Tenting sites are available.
