Facility and Accommodations

Camp Ramblewood is 1 hour north of Baltimore and 2 1/2 hours south of New York. It has an open-air dance pavilion, a dance hall, wooded hills with hiking trails, a pond with beach, a swimming pool, volleyball, tennis and basketball courts.

Housing is in male, female and couples cabins with attached indoor hot water showers, sinks and toilets. Dancers must bring towels, linens, pillows and blankets. Tenting sites available.

Full Time is Thursday 5pm to Sunday 4pm.

Part Time is Friday 3pm to Sunday 4pm.

All food, dances, workshops, and a bed are included. You must be registered and paid prior to camp. All checks must be mailed no later than August 3. Refunds (minus \$40 cancellation fee) are available through July 25. Registration is not transferable. A limited number of private rooms with two twin beds are available for \$90 per room.
